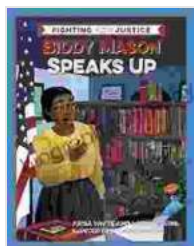


Biddy Mason Speaks Up: Fighting For Justice

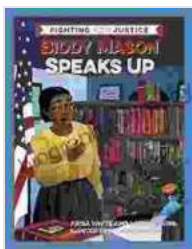

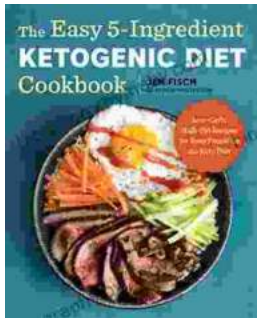
