The Moral of the Story

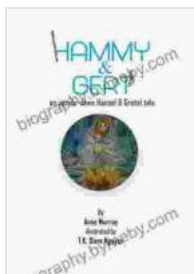

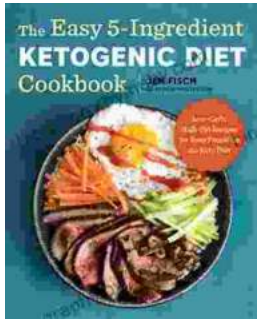
